Welcome to Meldreth Manor

Aurora Meldreth Manor supports children and young people aged 6-19 with highly complex learning difficulties associated with conditions such as cerebral palsy, acquired brain injury, degenerative conditions or autism spectrum conditions requiring a specialist approach.

As a registered children's home, we offer day placements alongside flexible residential placements for up to 52 weeks of the year. The support we provide enables each of our students to engage and progress at their own level within a living and learning environment designed to help them achieve their full potential as they reach adulthood.

Our facilities and curriculum

Learning at Aurora Meldreth Manor is focused on preparation for adulthood. Our child-led curriculum incorporates functional skills for independence and self-advocacy, so that every child is able to access and be accepted by their community. Students have the opportunity to work towards formal qualifications that bring challenge and achievement to their education experience.

Our specialist teaching team works collaboratively with therapists and teaching assistants to develop and deliver a meaningful, appropriate and personalised curriculum for every child. Our small classes are configured around diagnosis, communication needs, cognition and age appropriateness, with each class having distinctive characteristics according to the unique needs of its members.

A comprehensive specialist therapy team supports students at Aurora Meldreth Manor in line with each child's EHCP requirements, including through integrated physiotherapy, speech and language therapy, occupational therapy and music therapy. Nursing support is also a valued part of our provision.

Aurora Meldreth Manor offers a range of modern, creative spaces for learning – including well-equipped classrooms, multi-sensory areas and individual learning areas for quiet time – all of which are fully accessible with hoisting facilities available throughout.

We have a hydrotherapy pool, rebound therapy facility and multi-use activity area to support students' physical development, and plenty of outdoor learning spaces for them to enjoy a range of educational activities and to participate in our Forest school programme.

Our Residential Facilities

As a registered children's home, Aurora Meldreth Manor can also provide students with flexible, accessible accommodation and a vibrant yet homely space in which to live.

Our flats each have a spacious living/dining room with TV, games and eating areas, and individual bedrooms with a mix of bathing facilities and hoisting throughout for safe and easy movement for those with physical conditions. For those that can eat orally, fresh food is prepared daily by our chef and a variety of tastes and diets are catered for.

Our residential care team is passionate about ensuring that every individual is happy, healthy and well-supported. Alongside delivering personal care and helping with the management of epilepsy and other conditions, our staff support our residents to develop friendships, explore new interests and take advantage of after-school and social activities.

We encourage families to visit regularly and are able to offer limited family accommodation.
