# Aurora Linemere School

**A specialist day school providing education and therapeutic support for children and young people aged 5 to 19 who are autistic, and who may also have associated social, emotional and communication needs.**



## Welcome to our school

At Aurora Linemere, we believe in empowering individuality, building resilience and helping every pupil achieve their potential. We provide a supportive and inclusive environment where pupils are encouraged to explore their strengths, interests and abilities while developing confidence in themselves and their learning.

Many of our pupils may need support with sensory processing, emotional regulation and communication. Through specialist teaching, integrated therapeutic support, small class sizes and a nurturing approach, we help pupils engage positively with learning and enjoy school life.

## Our facilities and curriculum

Aurora Linemere School is located in North Somerset and provides a welcoming, purpose-built environment designed to support children and young people who may find larger mainstream environments challenging to navigate. Our bright, modern spaces are carefully planned to create a calm and supportive atmosphere where every pupil can thrive.

We adopt a “stage, not age” approach to learning, ensuring that education is tailored to each pupil’s individual developmental profile. Our broad and balanced curriculum builds on pupils’ strengths and starting points, enabling meaningful and sustained progress.

Our facilities include:

- A separate primary building with an internal quiet space and secure outdoor play area
- Specialist learning spaces for art, design technology and science
- A teaching kitchen with individual workstations for food technology
- Indoor and outdoor quiet spaces to support self-regulation and wellbeing
- Outdoor learning environments
- Sports facilities, including a multi-use games area (MUGA) and secure playing field
- Safe and accessible playground spaces
- A modern on-site kitchen providing healthy meals each day

Pupils also benefit from opportunities within Bristol and the surrounding areas, accessing a range of sports, leisure and cultural experiences that enrich learning and support community participation.

## Integrated Approach

We provide a holistic and therapeutic approach to supporting every pupil. Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) plans help staff understand each young person's individual profile, communication and support needs. These plans are regularly reviewed to ensure support remains personalised, responsive and effective.

The Thrive approach is embedded throughout the school, supporting emotional development and wellbeing across all aspects of school life. Our integrated therapeutic services include speech and language therapy, occupational therapy and clinical support. These professionals work closely with education staff to provide a joined-up approach that supports each pupil's learning, wellbeing and independence.
