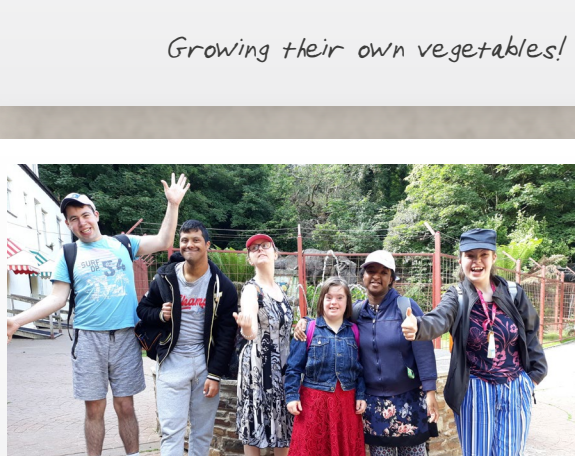
A TOUR AROUND THE HOUSES

Students at Foxes Lodge and Burrow are very excited to be using the crop from their vegetable patch in their cooking!

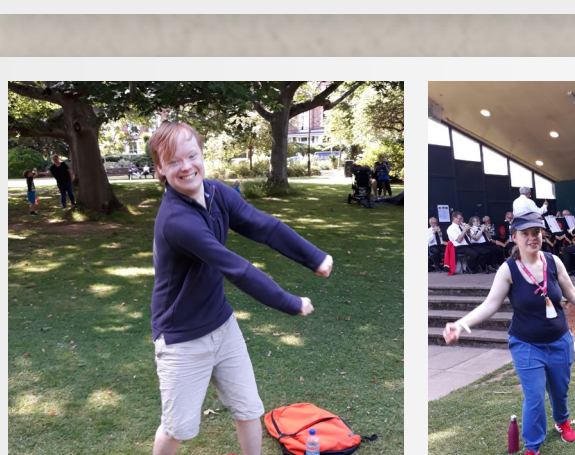

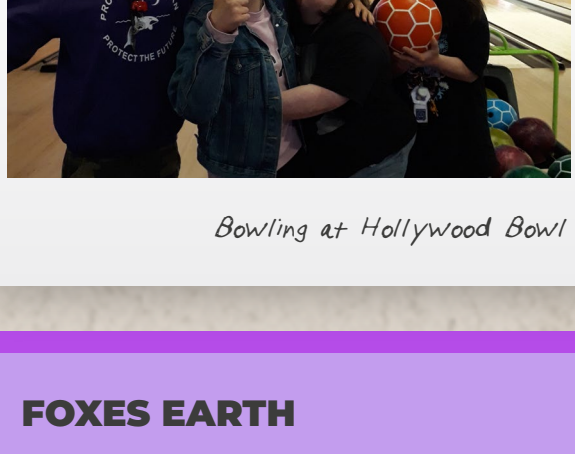

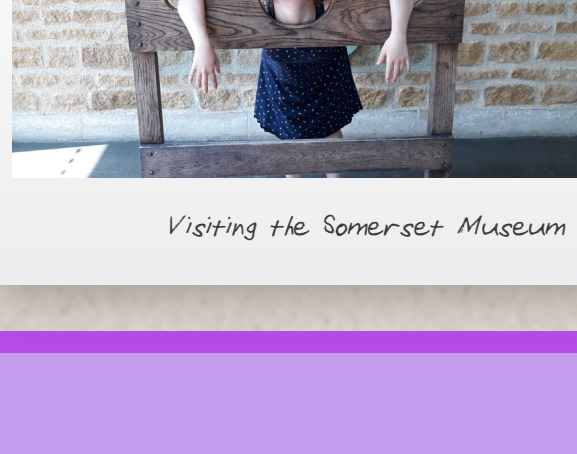


FOXES HIVE

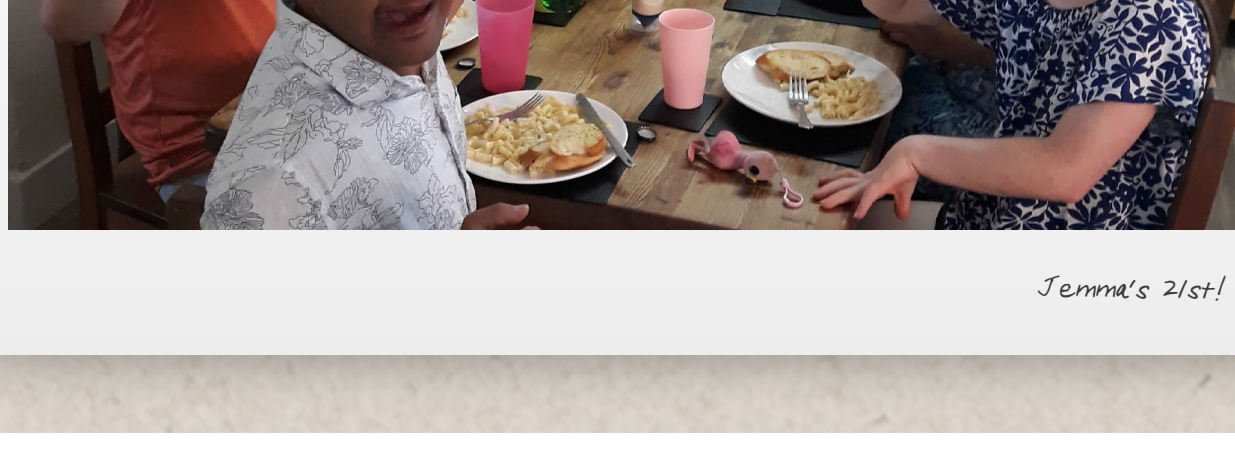
