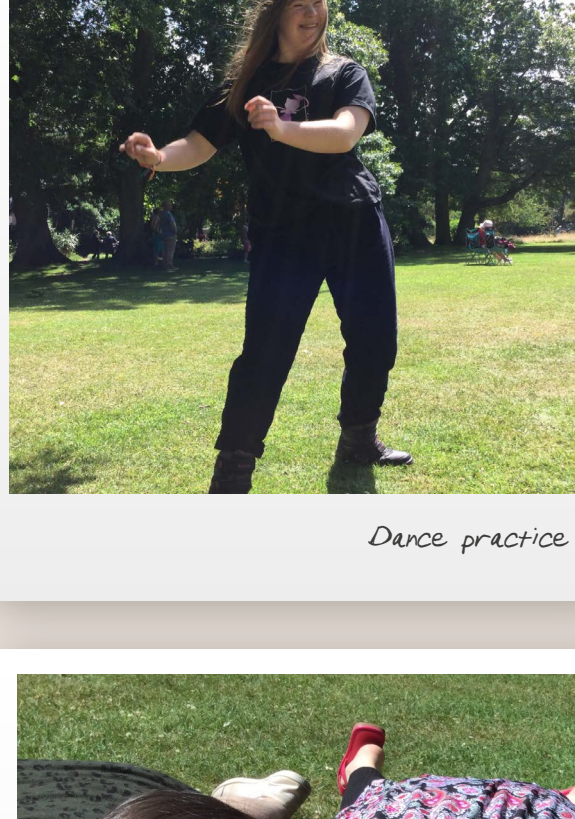
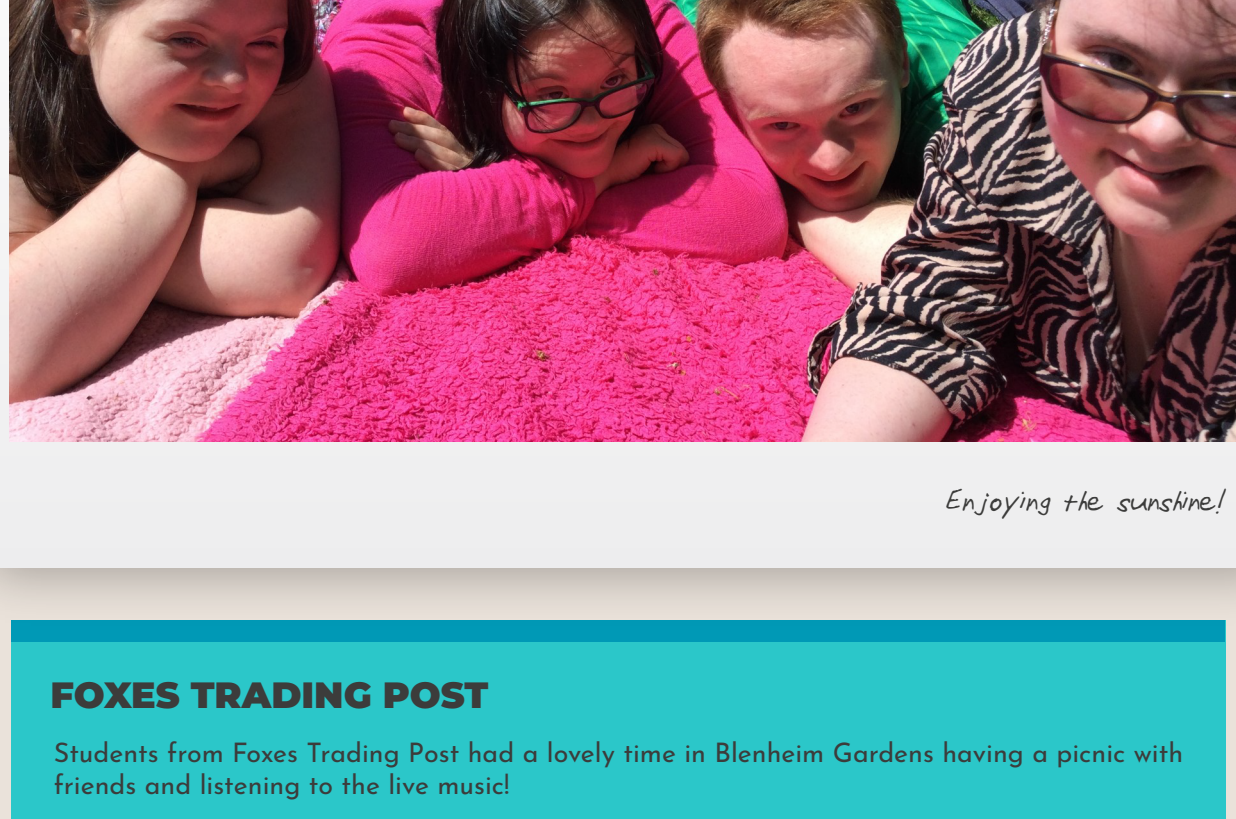
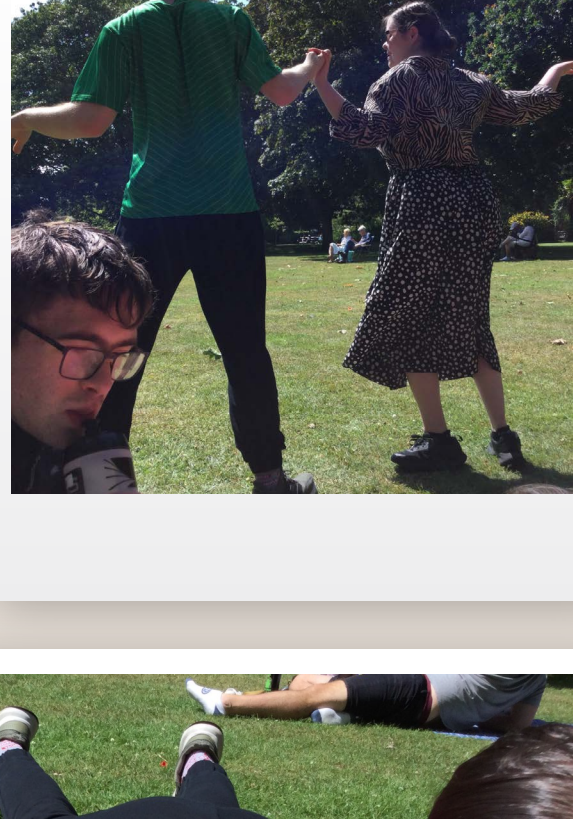
**A TOUR AROUND THE HOUSES***Foxes Hive will be joining us next week***FOXES LODGE & BURROW**

Another week full of fun and activities for students at Foxes Lodge and Burrow! They all went to the seafront and had some delicious fish and chips and then enjoyed a nice walk.

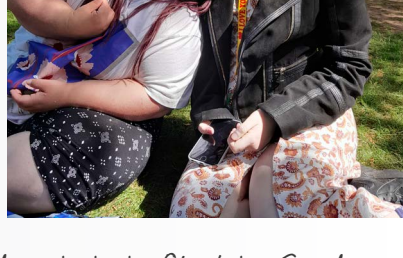
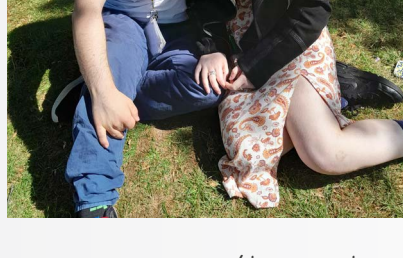
Some of our students signed up for Inclusive Cycle sessions and had a fantastic time riding the bikes - they all want to go back for more sessions!

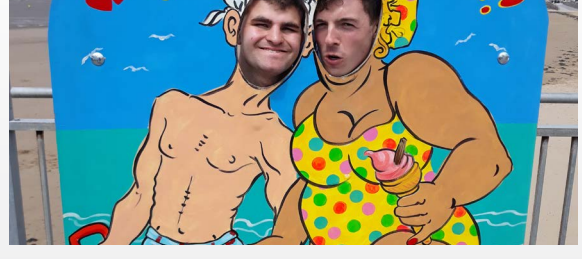
Foxes Earth enjoyed a visit to the Jubilee Cafe to play some Crazy Golf together this week!
