Expected skills acquisition- year 1

Writing- Write the letters of the alphabet in different contexts, join letters to make simple words, add prefixes for quantities. Structure simple sentences for meeting needs and play. Sit at a table, hold a pen correctly form lower case and capital letters.

Spelling- Start to use punctuation, and I pronoun in some contexts and joining words. Use these in context and in interactions with others.
