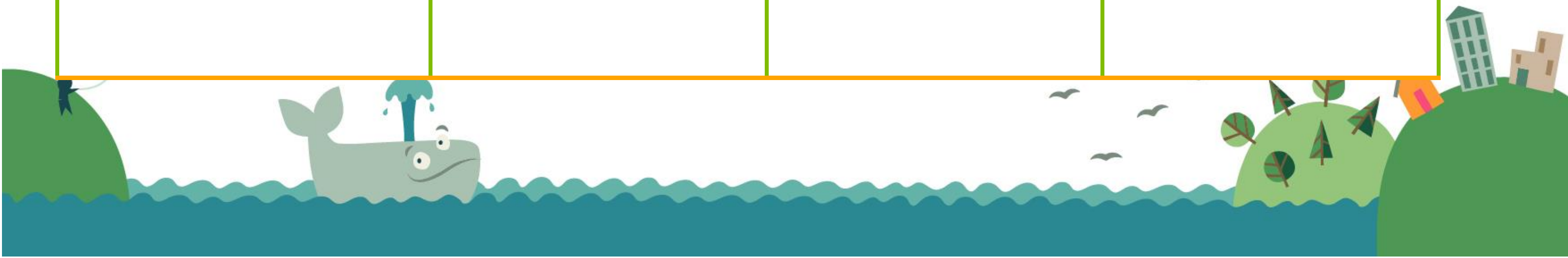


Eco-Schools Action Plan 2021-2022
