Course Duration	1-3 years (including prep course and/or ability levels and/or previous experience)
Entry Requirements	<p>Young people should not have a qualification of the same type, content and level.</p> <p>There are no formal entry requirements. However, a robust assessment process will take place to ensure the young person is on the correct programme of study and to confirm course duration.</p>
What's involved?	<p>If you haven't made your mind up yet, this is the qualification for you. You can choose your focus as you go, perhaps in serving, cooking, reception work, housekeeping or administration.</p> <p>To gain an NVQ, you need to show you've got a particular set of skills. You will review your current skills and find the best way to gain new ones - perhaps by trying new things at work, or by studying.</p> <p>NVQs are assessed at work. For each unit your assessor watches and asks questions as you perform a task, or looks at a portfolio of work that you've built as formal evidence of your learning. Then they confirm you've got the skills to do the job well.</p>
